

CodeRED Message from Mayor Jay Donecker Regarding COVID-19

Hello Reidsville citizens, this is Mayor Jay Donecker calling you in reference to the COVID-19 pandemic. To complement the Governor's Stay at Home Order, The City of Reidsville is adding the additional social distancing requirements for essential businesses in the City's local state of emergency beginning April 6th at 7pm. The complete 5-page document with much more detail has been placed upon our website and social media.

The following measures are required:

- Designate six foot distancing in check out and entry way lines.
- Sanitizing products must be available for employees, customers, and to clean carts/baskets used by customers.
- Separate operating hours for vulnerable population.
- Max allowance of individuals within the business at any point in time when total square footage is at or over 10,000 total square feet. A formula for this calculation is included in the document on our website and social media.
- All businesses must install at the entryway to the store 8 1/2 x 11 sign with the max number of allowed persons in the business in six-inch letters.
- For businesses less than 10,000 total square feet we are requesting these guidelines to be followed
- Businesses that can have more than 50 persons will have to keep an ongoing count to ensure compliance as people enter and leave

The following measures are suggested:

- One way aisles.
- Max allowance of individuals within the business at any point in time when total square footage is at or over 10,000 total square feet. The same formula previously referenced is recommended to be utilized.

Finally, I remind you to
